Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 24 June 2015.

You asked for the number of referrals made to Active Plus for Work Programme customers, for the period 1 January 2013 to 1 January 2015 by:-

- Truro Jobcentre Plus
- Exeter Jobcentre Plus
- Dorchester Jobcentre Plus.

Truro and Exeter Jobcentres have not referred any Work Programme customers to Active Plus. We do not have a Jobcentre in Dorchester.

It may help if I explain the arrangements for Work Programme customers. Our offices, like Truro and Exeter, refer customers to Work Programme Providers. Once on the Work Programme, the Provider may decide to fund a referral to another organisation such as Active Plus. This is a decision for the Work Programme Provider and not the Jobcentre Plus office. Strict funding rules mean that our offices cannot fund referrals for Work Programme customers to other organisations.
