Mobility and Safety Team funding of £188,000

Income of £127,000 (Department for Transport) and £28,000 (schools) towards delivering Bikeability Cycle Training.

Brisley farm link Ashford, Restricted Byway upgrade surfacing - £13,000

Department for Transport and ATOC on 4 Brompton Docks and 80 bikes - £25,000 from Local Sustainable Transport Fund for installation, maintenance and management £130,000

Improved cycle storage as part of wider Margate Station scheme - £5,000

Swale - Great Easthall £200,000

Swale - Thistle Hill - £100,000

Cycle Parking - Swale and Canterbury - £30,000
