FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Thank you for your email of 13th July 2018 requesting the following information:

Please provide copies of the following, subject to the usual redaction eg of commercial information i.e. figures:

Any Agreements, Treaties, Memoranda of Agreement, heads of agreement. or similar, between the UK Space Agency and China, Chinese corporations or agencies or companies, relating to space exploration, travel or utilisation, including for example satellites, earth observation, rockets, launches, manned space flight, telemetry tracking etc

The UK Space Agency (UKSA) enjoys a variety of productive relationships with China. However, there is only one extant Memorandum of Understanding between the UKSA and a Chinese entity. This is the Memorandum of Understanding with the China National Space Administration (CNSA) signed in December 2013, which may be found here:

The UKSA facilitates relationships between UK entities and China but does not generally seek to be a signatory in these relationships.

Additionally, while the UKSA attends, and may organise, events to which Chinese entities are invited, it does not enter into any agreements such as your request describes in order do so.

Appeals Procedure
