Further to our respective conversations, I copy below a link that takes you to Bradfield Parish Council's website which suggests that plans for a new footpath on Steam Mill Road are to be presented at the Parish meeting on 1 October. It would also appear to be the case that funding has been allocated by ECC.

This would suggest that the works to Steam Mill Road go further than simply repairing the existing highway...

I am concerned that if Members are not advised that this is the case, and Parish Members in attendance present evidence to show that it is, the recommendations about the junction at the top of Barrack Street may appear to have less credibility than they do in reality – presenting an avoidable risk that members will not accept the advice of the Highway Authority. Can you please look into this further to ensure that we have fully got to the bottom of this?

In my view it is important that any advice regarding the footpath is consistent with whatever evidence the Parish Council will be able to present.
