Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Request – 201016024

Thank you for your request received on 16 October 2020 in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

“Please provide the following info:

1) Appeal reference of applications submitted in relation to section 166 of the Data Protection Act 2018.

2) Indication if each application in (1) was within time or out of time.

3) If out of time, and where the application was admitted by the Tribunal, specify whether a request for an extension of time:

a) was requested by applicant, or

b) was considered by the Tribunal without a specific request by the applicant.

4) For all applications in (1), indicate if each application was:

a) admitted

b) dismissed (thrown out) quoting rule 22(6)(f) which states:

"An appellant must start proceedings before the Tribunal by sending or delivering to the Tribunal a notice of appeal so that it is received....

in the case of an application under section 166(2) of the Data Protection Act 2018 (orders to progress complaints), within 28 days of the expiry of six months from the date on which the Commissioner received the complaint."

Your request is being handled under the FOIA.

I have considered your request for information, but I am unable to answer it without further clarification. Section 1(3) of the FOIA does not oblige us to answer requests where we require further clarification to identify and locate the information requested.

So that I provide you with the right information, please can you further clarify which Tribunal you are requesting this information from? On receipt of this information I will continue to process your request.
