Freedom of Information Act 2000 - RFI20160121

Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act ('the Act') of 7th January 2016, seeking:

Please provide me with all Ariel articles and any associated article comments that have been published on New Gateway since you moved Ariel from your internet website to your intranet New Gateway. This should cover, at the very least the time period from 25th November 2015 until now.

Please find attached the information requested.

We are withholding information contained within the articles when we consider it to be 'personal information', under section 40(2) (personal information) of the Act. Under section 40(2) of the Act, personal information about identifiable living individuals is exempt if disclosure to a third party would breach one or more principles in the Data Protection Act 1998. The individuals concerned would not expect their personal data to be disclosed to a third party. To do so would be unfair; therefore, disclosure would breach the First Data Protection Principle (fair and lawful processing). This is particularly relevant as the level of expectation of individuals will have changed since Ariel articles have become only available to an internal BBC audience.
