Today, individuals and micro-businesses working seamlessly across the art/technology and culture/commerce divides are driving a generation of new culture, technology and value. This groundbreaking creative and business innovation occurs in ways and places largely invisible to traditional public and private support structures. Large technology companies provide labs for blue sky innovation, yet these don't fit with creative practice, where the most visionary individuals prefer to work in informal, independent creative networks. The step change is to provide agile and flexible support to accelerate these individuals and this practice; to connect culture with commerce.
