- Name of the asset
- What type of asset is it - building, land or heritage?
- Address (if applicable)
- Postcode (if applicable)
- The date it was disposed of
- The type of disposal (for example sale, community asset transfer, etc)
- How much it was sold for? (if applicable)
- Who it was sold to?"

I am treating your correspondence as requests for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) and will respond to all requests in this letter.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD). I can confirm that the MOD hold no record of any land, property or heritage assets in Lambeth Borough being disposed of by the RAF, the Royal Navy, the British Army or the MOD from 01 January 2010 to date.
