If decision is overturned at Tribunal following a face to face assessment conducted by ATOS and CAPITA what costs are recovered from these organisations.

No costs are recovered. The assessment report provided by the Health Professionals that carry out the assessment for Personal Independence Payment forms just one part of the evidence considered by the decision maker when making the decision. Also, the fact that a decision is overturned does not necessarily mean it was incorrect. Decisions are in the main overturned because of new written evidence not previously seen by the decision maker and, in particular, the oral evidence of the claimant on the day of the Tribunal.
