Could you please provide up to date information regarding the average length of time families with 'reasonable preference' who require a 2 bedroom property wait before being allocated a property either by successfully bidding for one or by any other method.

## Response

In 2017/18 RSL (Registered Social Landlords) and LBN (London Borough of Newham) properties let and average waiting time for the successful applicant for 2 bedroom properties was 2,820 (7.72 years). Please note, these figures are for all categories of applicant and all property types, taking the date of continuous application to the tenancy start date.
