## Access to information – Request No RFI 4746

Thank you for your request for the information detailed below which we received on 29 July 2019. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

You requested the following information and our response has been provided below:

How many Deer's have been culled in the Badger Cull Zones? Can you break them down into Zone areas, number found infected with BTB and from 2013 to 2018?

Natural England does not hold information on the number of deer culled in licensed badger control areas. Therefore, EIR exception 12(4)(a) – information not held, applies.
