Freedom of Information request - RFI20200518

Thank you for your request to the BBC of 28 April seeking the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'):

'Could you provide the latest figure for the total value of the BBC pension fund and full details of what the BBC fund currently invests in, including specific information on direct or indirect investments in fossil fuel companies (Shell, BP, Exxon etc).'

The information you have requested about the BBC pension scheme is not covered by the Act as it is held by the BBC Pensions Trust Ltd (BBC Pensions) and not by the BBC. BBC Pensions, as a private company which is legally separate from the BBC, is not subject to the Freedom of Information Act by virtue of section 6(1)(b)(ii) of the Act.

Appeal Rights
