Stuart Brewer raised a concern regarding current difficulties in obtaining police data which would allow LFRS to meet its requirements under the recent Cabinet Office Guidance "Keeping the Country Running: Natural Hazards \& Infrastructure" \\
Duncan Cullen advised that a request should be put through Darren Burton at the Police and if information was not forthcoming then the matter should be referred back to the Group. \\
Stuart Brewer still has some difficulties regarding sites that require Multi Agency Plan as police national guidance forbids the release of this information. Whilst a local work around has been implemented it is clear that this does not meet the requirements of the Cabinet Office guidance. It is possible that this is a national issue; Stuart Brewer has raised it with the CLG Central Resilience \& Emergencies Division and awaits a response. \\
Steve Potter will speak to Sgt Darren Burton regarding the information held back on site history. \\
