- Details of what the priority order is for the new Hubs and CAPs.
- Staff would like some detailed information regarding the rota review to enable consultation to start.
- Links to “Healthy Together” review
- Information on the potential of what type of resource will be at which CAP to ensure that transport if required and a response to appropriate level of job. Also consider the distance to travel to hospital units.
- Consider the use / funding of MFR in peripheral area or even home working paramedics.
- Health and wellbeing, truly needs to be key and central to any changes especially in regards to facilities at TDP, these should not be shared with the general public. Down time or breaks need to be able to take in a “quiet zone”.
- Business continuity re bad weather or lost of the use of a CAP/HUB.
- Ensure that make ready are effective and flexible.
