Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 28 August 2015. You asked:

"I have seen the recent release by Department re ESA deaths who where found fit for work released on 27/8/2015.

DWP recently generated ASMRs (age standardised mortality rates) for many categories of claimant, but not for the category of most interest: those who have been taken off IB/SDA after being found fit for work. Many of these move to JSA or other benefits so can I please have those statistics of those who died within 14 days after transferring to JSA or other benefits from IB /ESA."

Age Standardisation is an internationally recognised indicator which allows comparisons to be made between populations with different characteristics, such as age and gender. This approach is consistent with other published statistics on mortality, in particular by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) and the General Register Office for Scotland (GROS).

In answer to your request as a whole, we can confirm that the Department does hold some information falling within the description specified in your request. However, we estimate that the cost of complying with your request would exceed the appropriate limit of £600.

The appropriate limit has been specified in regulations and for central Government it is set at £600. This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 3½ working days in determining whether the Department holds the information, and locating, retrieving and extracting the information. Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) the Department is not obliged to comply with your request and we will not be processing your request further.
