Leonard Cheshire Disability is the UK's largest voluntary sector provider of services to disabled people. We support thousands of people with physical and learning disabilities across the UK, providing care in people's own homes, supported rented accommodation, residential homes and day centres, as well as through respite services.

Along with the majority of social care providers, we recognise that our care staff are our greatest asset and that they should be paid a fair wage for the essential work they do. In recent months we have sought to highlight this important issue, which is so key to the long term viability of the sector.

I wrote on 25 March about our desire for social care to become a Living Wage sector, but do not appear to have received a reply. I am writing again to request a meeting to discuss ways in which we can work together to address this.
