Your request has been processed in accordance with Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

“Please note that this report has been completed by an authorised employee as determined in Section 29 of the Fire (Scotland) Act 2005.

The ‘cause’ of the incident is an accurate determination following a detailed investigation and analysis of the evidence presented in relation to this incident”.

In line with the terms of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service has in place a procedure by which a review of the way in which we handle requests for information can be carried out. If you are dissatisfied by the way Scottish Fire and Rescue Service have dealt with your request or about any decision made by them in connection with your request, and wish a review to be carried out, please inform me of this by 13 January 2022. In doing so, it would be helpful if you could state the matter, which has given rise to your dissatisfaction.

Staff not involved in the original decision will handle any review.

Should you not be satisfied with the outcome of our review, you will then have the right to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner within 6 months. The Commissioner will decide whether your request has been dealt with properly, in accordance with the Act.
