## Bognor Regis Seafront Lights.

As you are aware for the 2017 August Bank Holiday the Bognor Regis Seafront Lights (BRSFL) and Bognor Kite Festival (BRKF) were allocated areas of West Park for their events. This resulted in a larger event for the Bognor Regis community.

The Kite Festival predominately used the site for the duration of the Bank Holiday weekend. The BRSFL made use of Silverton Avenue to roster the parade, and extra parking was accommodated at the rear area of West Park. Overall the feedback received was positive and both groups confirmed that the events this year benefitted from being on the same weekend.

After further review by ADC however the decision has been made that going forward the BRSFL will have sole use of West Park on 27 August 2018. Therefore the BRKF will not be able to operate on the August Bank Holiday weekend and the event would need to be accommodated on an alternative weekend.

I can confirm that I will be writing to the BRKF to advise them of the decision that has been made and both groups will need to follow the normal events application approval process when submitting their application and documentation.
