### **Freedom of Information Request**

This should, as per the earlier FOIA request with your reference number FOIR3966, also include the minutes of the meeting of the 17<sup>th</sup> July 2014.**

For the period after April 2014, DVLA holds information on one meeting which took place on the 17 July 2014. The agenda and minutes of this meeting are attached. However, information on BPA's Financial Report has been withheld as it falls under the exemption for information provided in confidence (section 41 of the FOIA).
