## Review of handling of response

Thank you for your email of 1 April 2014 regarding your request of 16 January 2014 for information about the University's annual expenditure on Elsevier journals.

In your email of 1 April you noted that you had not yet received a response to your request despite 20 working days having passed since you submitted your request. Under the terms of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 this constitutes a request for review.

The University responded to your request of 16 January 2014 on 2 April 2014. The delay enabled the University to supply you with a more complete response. Nevertheless we acknowledge that we failed to respond to your request within the 20 working days specified by the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, and would like to reiterate our sincere apologies for this delay.

## Right to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner
