Dear Sir,

Thank you for your request for information dated 23 May 2019 and detailed below.

*“How many staff are involved in relation to Brexit? Can I please ask for Organisation chart and if these staff have any other positions within the organisation. If this is case may I please also have their job descriptions.”*

Within the Department of Justice (DoJ), there are eight posts that work directly on Brexit. Three of these posts (Grade 7, Deputy Principal and Staff Officer) are full-time on Brexit and sit within the Safer Communities Directorate and five (Grade 5, 2 x Grade 7s, Deputy Principal and Staff Officer) have a significant part of their jobs focussed on Brexit within the Access to Justice Directorate. There is no single existing organisation chart for these posts as they are located in different business areas within the department.

Please note that Brexit also has an impact right across the DoJ, and it is therefore not possible to exactly quantify how many staff have had some involvement in Brexit work.

If you are unhappy with the result of your request for information you may request an internal review within two calendar months of the date of this letter. If you request an internal review please do so in writing stating the reasons to the address above.



If following an internal review you were to remain dissatisfied you may make a complaint to the Information Commissioner and ask him to investigate whether the DOJ has complied with the terms of the FOIA. You can write to the Information Commissioner at:
