## Freedom of Information request: FOI/99/19

I am writing in response to the Freedom of Information request you submitted to this office dated 12 April 2019, which is copied in bold below;

I should be grateful to receive any information about the UK Government's timetable for and progress on preparing and putting before Parliament - and FINALISING before 31 October 2019 -

- (a) a new US-UK extradition treaty (as, post-Brexit, the existing US-EU Extradition Treaty will no longer apply) and
- (b) a new US-UK inter-government agreement on extraterritoriality (in the context of the US CLOUD Act 2018).

The Freedom of Information Act (2000) gives individuals and organisations the right of access to all types of recorded information held, at the time the request is received, by public authorities such as the Attorney General's Office (AGO).

I have now been able to consider your request and can confirm that we do not hold the information you have requested.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to the above address.
