Freedom of Information request – RF120190901

Thank you for your request to the BBC of 24 May 2019 seeking the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'):

'Can you tell me what plans does the BBC have for it's commercial channels to make sure that viewers in the EU can watch them after Brexit?'

As set out in section 6(1)(b)(ii) of the Act, our subsidiaries (including BBC Studioworks Limited, UKTV, BBC Global News Ltd and BBC Studios Ltd), as well as the charities BBC Media Action and BBC Children in Need, are not subject to the Act. Therefore information regarding their activities is also not subject to the Act.
