Thanks for your response.

Specific dates are still somewhat up in the air due to ongoing ecological surveys (I believe there are bats and badgers in the immediate location - which is a relatively common issue at these old structures, and makes work programming something of a nightmare). We have further bat surveys in Jan and Feb following which time we may need to apply for a European Protected Species License. Following that I should be able to nail down the actual dates to something useful for you. Obviously, if the bridge becomes a more immediate concern in that period then we can step in as emergency works, but I very much doubt that will be an issue (I just like to have a Plan B if needed).

Happy for Prep World to be copied in, I prefer having these types of discussions early on so that we can try to work within the constraints as much as possible. Obviously it's not always possible, but we can usually accommodate most issues.
