Dear Mr McMahon,

Thank you for your email dated 29 November 2019 requesting information about City, University of London, made in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'). For ease of reference, your questions are reproduced below in bold followed by our response.

Please can you provide me of a copy of your organisations Bring your Own Device (BYOD) Policy.

I can confirm that we do hold information relevant to your request. Please find the information enclosed.

Please note that some information has been withheld under section 40(2) of the Act. Specifically, section 40(2) has been applied to obscure personal staff data. This information has been redacted to reduce the possibility of identification of and in order to protect the data subjects concerned. In accordance with Section 40 (2) it states that information is exempt from disclosure if it were to contravene any of the data protection principles to disclose it, in accordance with Article 5(1) of the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) i.e. that personal data shall be: (a) processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner in relation to individuals. Section 40(2) also states that if disclosure of the information were to contravene Article 21 of the GDPR (general processing: right to object to processing) then it shall also be exempt from disclosure.

We would like to take this opportunity to inform you, the University has a formal complaints and internal review process. If you are dissatisfied with the manner your request for information has been managed, please do so in writing, describe the original request, explain your grounds for dissatisfaction and include an address for correspondence to the Director of Information Technology at:
