RE: Request for Information – RFI3143

Thank you for your request for information which we are processing in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

For clarification, you requested the following information:

I wish to see all minutes, agendas and briefing notes for the Bristol Property Board meetings.

Extension to consider the public interest test

We wrote to you on 27 October 2020 to inform you that we did hold information that fell within the scope of your request, but that a qualified exemption (S43(2)) applied to that information. We advised that we required further time to consider the balance of the public interest in release of the information that fell under this exemption.

Section 10(3) of the FOIA enables a public authority to extend the 20 working day response limit up to a 'reasonable' time where it requires more time to determine the public interest.

In our previous letter of 27 October we estimated that we required an additional 20 working days to take a decision on where the balance of the public interest lies and that we would keep you informed if the decision would take longer.

We currently estimate that it will take a further 20 working days to reach our decision of where the public interest lies. Therefore, we hope to issue our response by 22 December 2020.

Right to Appeal

If you are not happy with the information that has been provided or the way in which your request has been handled you may request an internal review by writing to;
