Please provide or direct me to the total value of aid in any form, provided to the State of Israel, by the British Government, for the financial year 2015/16.

Official Development Assistance (ODA) is the route through which the British Government provides financial aid to support the development of countries.

I can confirm that UK stopped providing Official Development Assistance (ODA) to Israel in 1998-99. As such, no ODA was provided to Israel in the financial year 2015-16.
