FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 – INFORMATION REQUEST

Please accept our apologies for the delay in this response. I am writing to inform you that your request for information will not be processed. This is because the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the 'appropriate limit' as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. In accordance with s.17 of the Act this letter acts as a Refusal Notice.

As advised in our previous response, we do not hold a list, broken down by park, of all damaged/broken equipment, which has been unusable for the last three months. To obtain this information, would require investigation of every piece of playground equipment. There are 3724 individual items that would require investigation. If it took 2 minutes per item to investigate, then this would take 7448 minutes, this then equates to over 124 hours, which would exceed the limit.

You may wish to refine and resubmit your request so that it reduces the cost to within the appropriate limit. For example, agreeing to a shorter time period or reducing the number of questions in your request. Please contact me if you would like advice on how to do this.
