Re: Brunswick Park Community Hub

Dear Resident,

Earlier this year, a number of residents attended a pre-planning forum event relating to plans for a new “community hub” for Brunswick Park.

Following concerns raised at that meeting, changes have been made to the plans and you are invited to an exhibition which will offer you an opportunity to view the updated plans, ask questions relating to the planning consultation process and give us your views.

As you may be aware NHS Barnet need to re-provide the health centre which was recently damaged by fire. As a result they, in conjunction with the council, are proposing to build a new community facility on the site adjacent to Brunswick Park School (see map on back) which would re-provide the health centre and library. It will also incorporate a children’s centre and nursery, Acorn assessment centre for children with special needs children’s centre and nursery, pharmacy and cafe.

The exhibition will be held at Osidge Library, Osidge Lane, on 24 May, between 7pm and 9pm so you can give us your views on the proposals.

It is intended that the application is submitted following the event. You can expect to receive further letters from the planning department welcoming your contribution to the planning process shortly after.

Copies of the draft proposals will be available on the day and representatives from NHS Barnet and the council will be present to answer any questions you may have. If you are unable to attend, copies of the proposals will be available at Osidge Library indefinitely for future consultation.
