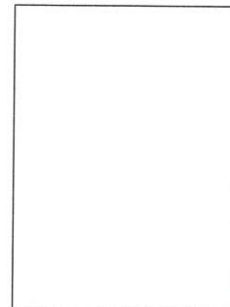

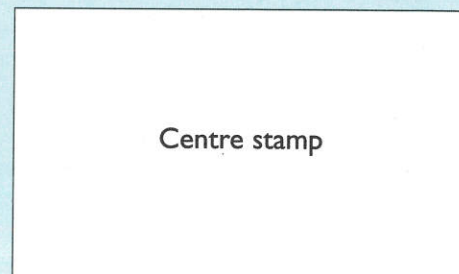

Please read the section appropriate to the pass for which you are applying.

Section A - Application on the basis of Age

To obtain your travel pass you will need to take your completed application form to your nearest East Riding of Yorkshire Council Customer Service Centre, Library or Mobile Library.

You will need to provide proof that you are of pensionable age and that you reside in the East Riding.

Section B - Application on basis of Disability

You may apply for a Travel Pass on the grounds of your disability. Please indicate which category you are applying under by entering the corresponding number in the box marked 'Disability category number' overleaf.

Disability category	Evidential Requirement
(1) Having a learning disability	Social Services Disabled Registration*
(2) Partially sighted or (3) Blind	Social Services Disabled Registration*
(4) Medically unfit to drive (otherwise than on the grounds of persistent misuse of drugs or alcohol)	Letter from DVLA or Completed questionnaire from GP confirming eligibility based on criteria listed (available from Passenger Services upon request)
(5) is without speech, including being unable to communicate orally in any language	Social Services Disabled Registration*
(6) has a disability, or has suffered an injury, which has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on his ability to walk	Proof of higher rate Mobility component of Disabled Living Allowance (DLA) or Disabled Car Badge (current) or Social Services Disabled Registration*
(7) Profoundly or severely deaf (with or without speech)	Social Services Disabled Registration*
(8) Limbless or loss of the use of both arms (or legs)	Letter from Sykes Street Artificial Limb Unit or Social Services Disabled Registration or visual verification by a member of staff (limbless)*
(9) War Pensioner	Proof of receipt of war pension

*Having a Disabled Registration with East Riding Social Services does not give automatic entitlement to a travel pass.

Where requested, disabled registrations must list the person's disabilities in sufficient detail to confirm eligibility based on the listed criteria.

Section C - Application for a Companion Travel Pass

If you are unable to use public transport without assistance you may apply for a Travel Pass entitling a companion to travel with you at the concessionary fare. You will need to provide a letter from your doctor confirming that you are unable to use public transport without a companion.

Section D - Library and Leisure Card Numbers (optional)

If you have either a Library card and or a Leisure card for use within the East Riding, please enter their respective numbers. The Council is looking into extending the use of the travel card to also work as your Library and Leisure cards as applicable to reduce the number of cards you need to carry.
