
#### 4) OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1) Route No. 120 should be separated from Route No. 282 between Yeading, White Hart and Northolt Station during all periods, where possible.
- 4.2) Route No. 120 should be separated from Route No. 90 between Yeading, White Hart and Northolt Station during all periods, where possible.
- 4.3) When compiling schedules Tenderers are asked to consider passengers making connections to other services at the following locations: Hounslow Central Station, Southall Station and Northolt Station.
- 4.4) Route No. 120 can suffer unpredictable traffic delays in the Lady Margaret Road, Southall, Hounslow Central Station and Northolt target areas.
- 4.5) Special events in the Southall area (religious festivals etc) can cause severe delays to all bus services within the area and may entail road closures by the Metropolitan Police. When these occur, some services, such as Route No. 120, may be diverted from their normal line of route. The successful Tenderer will be advised of the relevant local contacts for both London Buses' Network Operations and the Metropolitan Police.
- 4.6) Crossrail will connect the City, Canary Wharf, the West End and Heathrow Airport to commuter areas east and west of the capital. Major construction of the railway began in 2010, with services expected to commence in 2018. The construction impacts of Crossrail could affect Route No. 120 and it is anticipated that some passenger demand for Route No. 120 would shift to this line when it opens. Route No. 120 will be reviewed closer to the opening date.
- 4.7) The 2012 Olympic Games open on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> July and close on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> August. The 2012 Paralympic Games start on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> August and close on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> September. The Games will result in additional passenger demand across the network, requiring additional capacity on some routes. There will also be a number of road closures in the event areas resulting in route diversions. Operators should be aware there will be implications to them during this time. Full details and any extra resource required will be negotiated with the operator at a later date.


