

Requesting an internal review

Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council accepts that sometimes an applicant may not agree with the decision made about their information request. If this is the case there is a procedure to allow the decision to be reviewed.

If you wish to ask for the decision to be reviewed you should make your request in writing to:-

or via email to: dpo@rotherham.gov.uk - mark your email for the attention of the Data Protection Officer.

You should state the reason for your request, for example, why you feel you should have received more information.

Your request will be fully investigated and will be dealt with by a staff member who was not involved in the original decision. Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council will then write to you to advise the outcome of your request.

If you are dissatisfied with the results of the review you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner.
