**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NUMBER 0190/2012**

I refer to your request for information dated 13 March 2012, which was received by Strathclyde Police on that date. Your request has now been considered and on 10 April 2012, a decision was made to grant your request in full. As such, the information you have requested is detailed below.

Once informed of the Review Panel's decision, if you are still not satisfied, then you are entitled to apply to the Scottish Information Commissioner within six months for a decision.
