## BOROUGH OF LOWESTOFT

### AMENDING BYELAW

made on the 14th day of April, 1965 by the Mayor,  
Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Lowestoft acting by  
the Council under Section 164 of the Public Health Act, 1875  
for regulating

THE FLYING OF POWER-DRIVEN MODEL AIRCRAFT  
in the pleasure ground known as Normanston Park within the said Borough.

Byelaw 3 of the Byelaws made on the 12th day of December, 1951, by  
the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Lowestoft and confirmed  
by the Secretary of State on the 12th day of February, 1952, for regulating the  
flying of power-driven model aircraft in certain of the pleasure grounds within  
the said Borough is hereby repealed and the following bye-law is substituted  
therefore :—

“ 3. A person shall not fly or permit to fly any power-driven model  
aircraft except on the days and during the hours specified in the following table  
in any part of the pleasure ground known as Normanston Park.

<i>Table</i>	
<i>Days</i>	<i>Hours</i>
Sundays	10 a.m. to 12 noon.
Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 1st May and 30th September	10 a.m. to 8.30 p.m. or to half-an-hour after sunset whichever shall be the earlier.
Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 1st October and 30th April	10 a.m. to half-an-hour after sunset.”

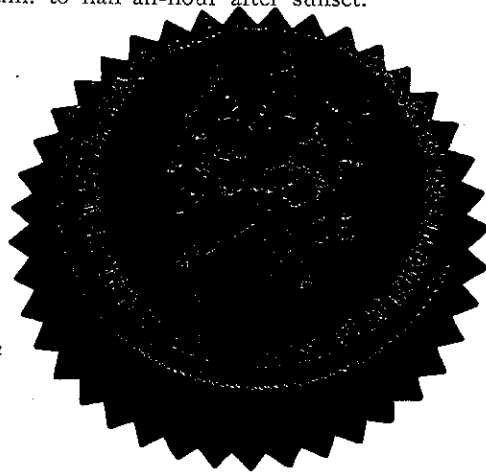
