- 1 Is CAFCASS funded by Coram Adoption Agency?
- If the answer, to the above question is yes. Does this not amount to a serious and dangerous conflict of interests in 'Best Interests of children''??
- 3 How long have CAFCASS been taking funding from a Private Adoption Agency and for what purpose??
- Whos interests are being served. Innocent falsely accused parents who lose their children to forced adoptions, in secret family courts, or Coram who then go on to sell these children, to the highest bidder??
