Tunnel length

Please find attached a spreadsheet labelled "FOI201800572 Tunnel Length.xls" detailing the length of all of the tunnels above except for "New Furnace Tunnel" where we hold no recorded information.

Tunnel Gauge

I can confirm we hold this information, however, section 21 of the FOIA allows us to withhold information in response to a request if it is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means.
