## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000**

I have considered your appeal against the decision in relation to your request for access to information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I have also considered information from the departments that provided information regarding the Council's response to your request.

My decision is that your appeal is upheld.

The reasons for my decision are set out below.

I uphold this appeal. While I suspect we have actually supplied the vast majority of this information I cannot be sure without us re-drafting it with reference to each number as the applicant has requested. I also struggled to follow the appeal for the same reason so I suggest we redraft answering each question separately and the appeal is then resubmitted and I will then consider it.
