REQUEST FOR REVIEW UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002 ("THE ACT")

I refer to your email received by Community Safety Glasgow ("CSG") on 21 October 2014 which I am treating as a formal request for review of CSG's response to your initial request for information which was received on 22 September 2014.

YOUR REQUEST

You requested the following information:

I would like copies of the CCTV footage obtained from George Square on Thursday and Friday last week.

THE RESPONSE

On 21st October 2014 Iain Paterson, Corporate Support Manager at CSG, wrote to you to advise in accordance with section 17(1)(b) of the Act that CSG had passed the information to Police Scotland and accordingly no longer held the information. You were further advised that you should contact Police Scotland if you wished to request access to the information.

THE REVIEW REQUEST

On 21st October 2014 you wrote to CSG requesting a review of CSG's initial response on the basis that you were not satisfied that CSG no longer held the information.

THE REVIEW DECISION

I have now carried out a full and impartial review of the initial response provided to you and would advise that I uphold the initial response in which you were notified in accordance with section 17(1)(b) of the Act that CSG has now passed the information to Police Scotland as part of an ongoing enquiry and therefore no longer holds the information.

I am satisfied that the information has been passed to Police Scotland and that the CSG no longer holds the information.
