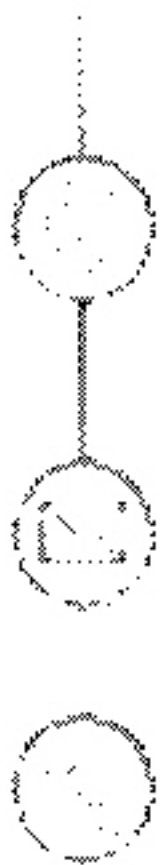
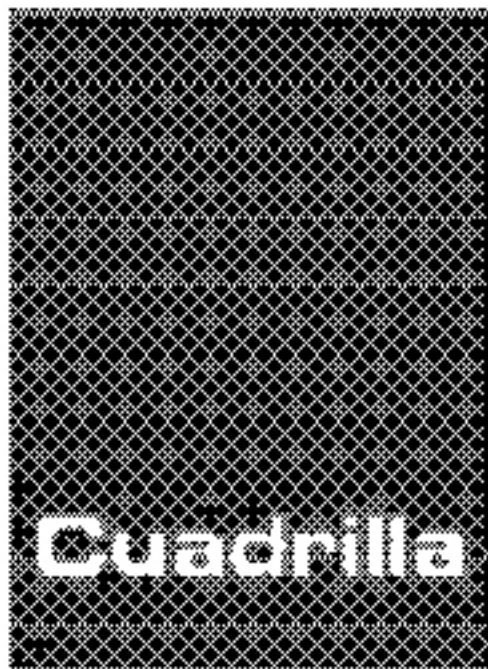
Hi Jonathan

Please see attached letter. I trust this makes sense.

With regards to the point raised the traffic scenarios are not similar to other sites unfortunately. The alternative routing is based on the risk assessment. The purpose of the risk assessment is to prevent rather than react to situations which are likely to compromise highway safety and the free flowing of traffic. Subsequently the risk assessment approach in consultation with the Police will codify the measures to be taken to prevent obstructions e.g. lock on's/ jumping on top of vehicles/ jumping in front of vehicles before they happen. Over the last 3 months there have been numerous evidential occasions where by vehicles both entering and leaving site have been targeted and subsequently disrupted the traffic flow along the A583.

I hope this makes sense please call me if you wish to discuss further.

Would it be possible please for you to produce a short letter to go with this to say that you are applying for an amendment to the approved TMP. It would just help as to how it is presented on our website.

We will consult on the basis of your current submitted draft. However on section 3.7.1 it is not very clear when the alternative routing will operate. Could we not just say that the normal approved routing will not operate on any occasion when any part of the A583 is closed to traffic by the police (due to protestor activity or accident) in which case you be able to use right in right out, right in left out or left in right out or any combination of the options.

This is how routing agreements operate on other sites that we regulate.

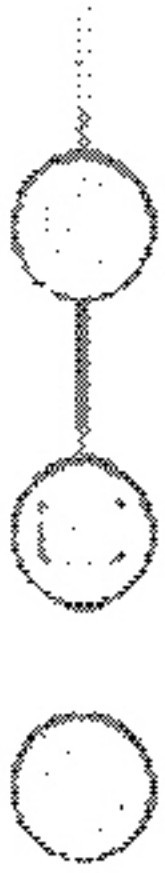
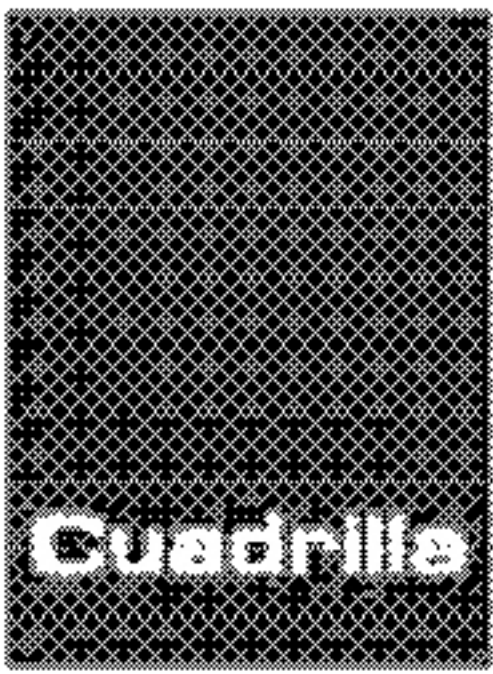
