Letter confirming the outcome of internal review – Ref No CA21

We refer to your emails of 20 September and 4 October 2018 where you requested information about Mr Martin Whiteley and our response of 23 October 2018.

Further to your request for a review of our response, we have now conducted such a review and the decision has been upheld for the following reasons:

- 1. The Authority maintains its reliance on the costs exemption. An email search has already been undertaken and not revealed any data.
- 2. The Authority maintains its reliance on the personal data exemption, legal advice is that disclosure of personal data would be contrary to the GDPR.

The Authority would point out that, since your request, there have been discussions regarding this matter at both the Overview & Scrutiny and Audit and Governance Committees, but these minutes are in the public domain as they are published on the Authority's website.
