I am writing to request an internal review of Children and Family Court Advisory Support Service's handling of my FOI request 'Children seen in Private Law Proceedings'.

I do not appear to have received the information about how many cases were allocated to a Family Courts Adviser.

I do not appear to have received the information relating the numbers of Applications which proceeded to a Court Hearing and the number of Children & Young people whose 'Wishes and Feelings' were ascertained.

Please note: A Senior Officer who was not party to the original decision on whether to release the information will conduct the internal review. The internal reviewer will review the manner in which the application was dealt with and is empowered to either uphold or overturn the original decision.

This request was received on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2012 and I will be dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Cafcass is required to notify you as to the final decision made regarding your internal review. Cafcass aim to deal with internal reviews within 4 weeks of receiving the request. You will receive a response on or before the 24<sup>th</sup> April 2012.
