DWP Response

We have taken your request to be in response to the reply you received from the Department for FOI 3524 dated 10th September 2015.

Within that response a link was provided to the DWP Tabulation Tool and also some advice under Section 16 of the FOI Act on how you can narrow your request so it falls within the appropriate cost limit of £600. The onus is therefore on yourself, as requestor, to limit the scope of the information you want. As you have not provided this, the Section 12 costs exemption still applies.
