Thank you for sending through the documentation relating to the proposals for the substation site at Chilling. That is most helpful. As we discussed yesterday, due to the timescale requirements on the interconnector project and the early stage that your project is at, I will be putting forward a report for member approval which covers the detail of the interconnector cables and also makes mention of your project in order to ensure that members are as fully briefed as possible on the related parts of the scheme.

Our main concern relates to the impacts on Chilling Lane during the construction of the new substation building and I look forward to receiving more information in that regard once your various transport studies have been completed.

As far as the ponds are concerned;

P3 is not in our ownership

P1, P2, P4, P5 P6 are all within our ownership and managed by HCC's Countryside Service. Provided that there is no vehicular access required beyond Chilling Lane and no equipment is to be left on site I cannot see any problems with DNA samples being taken next week however please ensure that either you or your ecologists contact the site manager, in advance of the actual visits so that he is aware of who is on site and when.

P7 is also in HCC ownership however is on tenanted property. I note that it is not currently listed as access required however if this changes please let me know and I will arrange access however this will require a longer notice period.

This also seems a timely moment at which to bring up the subject of HCC's fees in dealing with this matter. Clearly we are going to have some officer

time involved in dealing with access arrangements and other matters relating to your development and I would be grateful if you could confirm that National Grid will be meeting costs incurred by the Council in this regard.

Flook forward to hearing from you further in due course.

Further to our telephone conversation earlier I attach as background a copy of the letter and illustrations sent to Fareham BC regarding the scheme. (this is similar to information I shared with Karen Murray before Christmas in a presentation). At this stage we are very much in the early stage of our detailed design for the scheme. We will be undertaking surveys to support the development of a suitable route for AlLs and construction traffic. This work is not planned to be completed until this Autumn.

I realise that this is short notice but our ecologists are on site next week and they have asked whether it is possible to do eDNA survey at the same time as the phase 1 walk over we are conducting at our site on Monday and Tuesday. The ponds that we would need to access are Ponds P1, P2, P3, P4, P5 and

P6 shown on the attached drawing. Alternatively could you let me know when it would be possible to arrange access for these?

As discussed I am happy to come down and take you through the scheme in detail when our design has developed further.


