Thank you for your email. The consultation was formally opened on March 27, with an email sent to 112 key stakeholders in Lambeth and London wide. Additionally we emailed 7 local amenity groups. The consultation letter was hand delivered to approximately 1200 properties in the local community on Good Friday (March 28). We've already received some forms back, and have had a number of responses online so we know information is in the community. Posters will be installed, where space permits, at approximately five bus stops/shelters in the area within the next two weeks, helping publicise the consultation. The letter and online consultation are part of the process which fulfils the requirement for us to consult under Section 183 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999.
