Dear Mr Lockhart

Further to your email of 8 April, which has been considered to be a request for information under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000; I have been asked to reply on behalf of the Ministry of Defence (MOD).

In your email you requested the following:

“Please show all communications between AOC 22 Group RAF and the AOC RAF Air Cadets in relation to the dismissal or restriction of action of civilian welfare committee's and their position in law in relation to the RAFAC and the Charity Commission regulations over the past five years. This does not include the 863 Squadron affair.”

Under the FOI Act the MOD is obliged to consider the release of recorded information held by the Department. However, the MOD requires further information in order to determine whether it holds any information within the scope of your request. In particular, please could you clarify if by “Air Officer Commanding the RAF Air Cadets” you are referring to the Commandant of the RAF Air Cadets? Additionally, it is not known what is meant in your email by “civilian welfare committee”. Please could you clarify if you mean RAF Air Cadet Squadron Civilian Committees?

Once you have clarified your request, I will be pleased to consider it again. Please remember to quote the reference number above in any future communications.
