Alex is looking to tweak the definition of habitable rooms so it excludes kitchens. Theoretically, if all the flats in the Richard Hopkinson scheme had standalone kitchens then the total number of habitable rooms would be 52, so overage would be payable on the amount over 39, so (52-39) x £15,000 = £195,000. Under the present definition this would be payable notwithstanding no actual increase in the floorspace having been obtained. Therefore, I can see why Alex is looking to exclude kitchens from the definition.

I've put in another call to Alex but in the meantime, if you have any comments, please let me know.

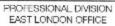
