There is likely to be recommendation to demolish the building in advance of the regeneration programme at the Central Hill estate. In the circumstances it probably would be better to look at other alternative options. I am sorry that I cannot be more positive at this stage as I am acutely aware of the demand for youth facilities in the Gypsy Hill ward.
