I refer to your e-mail of 31 May in which you asked:

I am writing to make a request under the Freedom of Information act for copies of any correspondence between the DECC or any of it's constituent parts with either Sunderland Council or the three MP's whose constituencies include Sunderland (Sunderland Central, Houghton and Sunderland South, Washington and Sunderland West) on the subject of Underground Coal Gasification from 1st January 2008 to 31st May 2015.

I have considered your request in accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 ('the EIRs') as the information you have sought disclosure of, in our view, falls within the definition of 'environmental information' as stated in the EIRs.

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the Department does not hold any information within the scope of your request.
