Marine Scotland Science (MSS) has reviewed the submitted plan and has provided the following comments.

marine mammals

MSS agree that it is appropriate for vessels to follow the Scottish Marine Wildlife Watching Code when operating around marine mammals. We recommend that vessels keep a watch for marine mammals, in order to ensure that they are able to behave appropriately if the animals are around. Monitoring data presented in the ES demonstrated that dolphins were regularly present at the site, so vessels will need to become familiar with the behaviour standards expected.
