Dear Val and Chris,

Clause 2(j) of the Schedule to the HRO requires us to include the following in the CEMD: 'methods for the investigation of contamination and ground gas on site and an assessment of ground water quality and any necessary remediation'. Aberdeen Harbour Board commissioned this work some time ago; however, due to serious illness within our consultant team, we've been unable to finalise the report for it to be included in the CEMD that was submitted on Friday.

In November we met with Environmental Health officers at Aberdeen City Council to discuss the draft report and agree changes. The draft report concluded that the risks associated with ground gas and groundwater quality are low; ACC agree with this conclusion but requested that we incorporate additional data to support the findings. I have contacted ACC to inform them of the delay and to confirm that we will send them the final report within the next two weeks.

I will send you a copy of the report and any subsequent responses from ACC. No other consultees have expressed an interest in this study during the informal consultation on the CEMD: it was requested by ACC only in their response to the HRO consultation. It is not a condition of the Marine Licences.
